Did you know there are over 100 types of Dementia? The Care Team at St Patrick's Green does and they understand that each type requires a different approach to care. Every team member in our Aged Care Home undertakes Dementia training, which supports the individual style of care they provide to each of the residents living with Dementia in Synergy House.

Getting to know our resident's diagnosis is the first step in creating a personalised care plan for them and will determine the types of lifestyle choices (activities) we will recommend. By understanding our resident's type of Dementia, our team can then provide that resident with the appropriate support. 'Whilst a lot of Aged Care Homes have something similar to Synergy House, a lot of them don't have a different approach for each type of Dementia – instead we often see the same approach being used for every resident. We're unique here at St Patrick's Green because we care for each of our residents living with Dementia in different ways,' said Lisa Norwood, Lifestyle Team Leader.

It all comes back to person-centred care: in our Aged Care Home we get to know our residents, their lives and their reality. When a new resident moves in, we sit down with their family to gain a better understanding of their life history and choices. This information is then given out to our Care Team so they can take a personalised approach when caring for and building a relationship with that resident. The St Patrick's Green team doesn't just know the resident as Jan who lives in room 622, but instead they know she is Jan who spent her years dancing and now listening to music helps her to feel calm.

In Synergy House we treat each of our residents as the individuals they are. The residents of our Aged Care Home living with Dementia are no different to any other resident, they are treated the same and involved in our community. St Patrick's Green provides a friendly and supportive environment, with all staff proud supporters of the Dementia Friends program.

Making a Smooth Transition into Aged Care

Anyone who's had a loved one move into a Residential Aged Care Home knows what a daunting experience it can be. For many, it comes with mixed emotions; some might be sad about leaving the family home, scared, or simply unwilling to accept that they need care — all of these are perfectly normal emotions for such a big decision. At St Patrick's Green we recognise that some people need a little extra help transitioning into Aged Care, whether it be the new resident or their family. That's why we have introduced a Transition Nurse role at our Aged Care Home in Kogarah, and it's a game changer for the industry.

We'd like to introduce you to Michelle Pool, the Transition Nurse at St Patrick's Green, who brings 13 years' experience in nursing, as well as an empathetic and caring nature. We're proud to have her on board to help our residents settle into life at the village. As Transition Nurse, Michelle buddies with new residents to orientate, clinically assess, answer questions, follow-up, and to be the first friendly face our residents get to know.

When we spoke to Michelle, she said 'Moving into our Aged Care Home is a big step, so I'm glad I can be here to make the transition smoother for our residents. Sometimes when they arrive, you can see in their face that they're scared or overwhelmed with the change. My job is to make them feel at ease and listen to their concerns — it's a role which suits my maternal nature. I spend their first day getting them settled in, and by the time I pop in for a follow-up the next day I usually get a smile and can see them starting to relax.'

On the first day our Transition Nurse will meet and greet the new resident, showing them around their suite, the Aged Care Home, and the village community areas. After that, Michelle will organise lunch in the Dining Room with the new resident and their family. 'Having loved ones here for lunch on the first day creates a comfortable environment and helps our residents to settle in and become familiar with the village. Over the following weeks, I'll continue to check in to help our resident organise anything that will make their life at St Patrick's Green better,' said Michelle.

Behind the scenes, our Transition Nurse also puts her RN skills to good use. On the first day, Michelle will



complete all of the initial assessments, organise all of the resident's medications, notify the pharmacy, and contact the GP.

When asked what her favourite moment at St Patrick's Green has been so far, Michelle answered, 'A few weeks ago a lady moved in and initially she really didn't want to be here. She didn't want to leave her home, her family was feeling guilty, and the lady was very quiet and reserved. Last week I called the family to check in and they told me "Oh, she really likes it there now, she wants to stay!" I was so happy to hear that she's settled in nicely. I think once the shock of moving into an Aged Care Home wore off, she was able to realise that a lot of pressure has been taken off her; she doesn't have to worry about meals anymore, or doing the washing or cleaning, she can just relax.'

Ensuring residents feel safe, comfortable and well-cared for is key to assisting with their transition process. 'I enjoy working in Aged Care and building relationships with our residents and their families,' said Michelle, and what more could we ask for from our Transition Nurse? After all, building strong relationships between our residents, their families, and our team members is the best way to make St Patrick's Green feel like home.

An Insider's Perspective on the Sydney Housing Market



With so much in the news about housing prices in Sydney, and many of our readers left wondering if now is a good time to sell or not, we decided to get to the bottom of our current housing market.

We sat down with Shaun Ramani, a local real estate agent based in Sans Souci, to get an insider's perspective.

What is happening with the current housing market?

It's clear that the Sydney Housing Market is experiencing a sustained correction. In the past few years, sellers have experienced a booming market, where agents were able to sell a property with their eyes closed. However, now we are experiencing a 'level playing field' for both buyers and sellers. The primary reason for this shift in the market place is due to the increased tightening of the bank's lending criteria this came as a result of the pressure put on banks by the Royal Commission.

Is now a good time to sell?

Yes, don't be scared by the media! Now is a great time because buyers are currently able to lock in low interest rates for the next 5 years. If you are thinking of selling, I would suggest sooner rather than later;

there has been quite a bit of talk about an increase in interest rates within the next 6 months which will decrease a buyer's borrowing capacity.

Now is also a good time to sell for the Australian community. Australian Prudential Regulation Authority (APRA) have tightened lending restrictions on foreign investors, which in turn gives Australian residents a better opportunity to buy property, in particular first home buyers.

Are houses actually selling in our area at the moment?
